Chinese Raffle baskets will be available, with blind bids on our lodge website or in person in the lounge up until the event. As always the Chinese Raffle Baskets are more unique and of higher value. A 50/50 drawing will be available in the Lodge. All winners will be drawn by the PER Association on Saturday August 8, 2020 at 7pm and winners not present will be notified by phone and/or e-mail. The lodge is practicing social distancing and adhering to all State of Ohio guidelines, however we encourage members & guests to still attend the raffle in person should they want to.

To play the Main Raffle Only pre-buy numbers will be sold, 60 are already sold, 60 are still available. If you want a specific remaining number, those are available only at the lounge. Through our website, www.bereaelks.com, \$20 pre-buy numbers are on sale by clicking on the "summer basket raffle" tab. You will be assigned the next chronological number that is unsold. Sales will end Friday August 7th or when all 120 pre-buy numbers are sold.

To bid on Chinese Raffle Baskets Chinese Raffle Baskets will be available for viewing and bidding on our website, www.bereaelks.com, also by clicking on the "summer basket raffle" tab. Anyone may submit a bid on the site, highest bid amounts to-date will be updated each Sunday. Bids can also be made in person in the lounge. Bids must be submitted via website or in the lounge by Friday August 7th.

To play the 50/50 drawing, tickets are \$5 each and will be available only in the lounge. There is no limit on how many tickets may be purchased, the more you buy, the better your chances to win! You must write your name and contact info on back of tickets. Cutoff to buy is close-of-business on Friday August 7th.


